Quiet Light is the last piece Jeff designed for Monadnock and it is fitting that it illustrates the beauty and variety of nature. Jeff died on February 14, 2005. He will be missed by his many friends at Monadnock.

Printing Specifications

This brochure was printed on a Heidelberg Speedmaster 102 CD/CIP $3 - 28^{\circ} x 40^{\circ} - 8/color$ Press. The text was run as one sheetwise 12 page form and the cover was run sheetwise on a threeup form.

The tone reproduction curves were adjusted to enhance details of the images. Images were printed in halftone, duotone, tritone and 4/c process. All screen resolutions are 175 line. A dot-for-dot satin press varnish was run on all forms.
